- In Malawi alone, a country of 60 million, 45 million have no safe drinking water.

Water

It was a four-hour journey, and most of the women and children made that walk twice a day. No time for anything else. Not even a moment's respite from the heat of the afternoon. Just walking and carrying. Inside the bucket was a mixture of water, dirt, algae, cow and goat feces, bacteria, mosquito larvae and other insect eggs, parasites, and various waterborne diseases waiting for a host. This is what they walked miles and miles to carry back to their homes.



Wells

Below the ground they walked upon was a wealth of cool drinking water. It is simply a matter of digging deeper than hands can dig.
